BSM Associate Director Christi Brazile married Josh Matthews on November 5. Christi has been on UTA BSM staff for over eight years, since 2003.

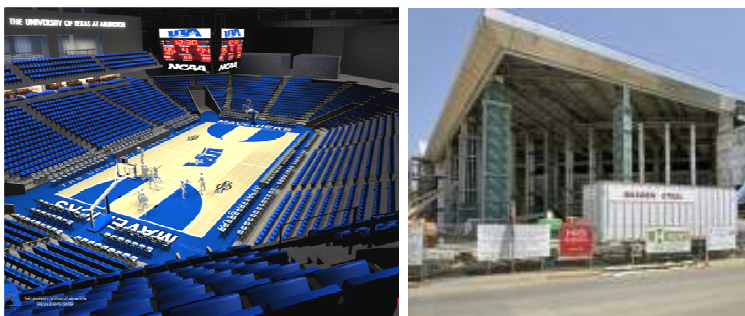

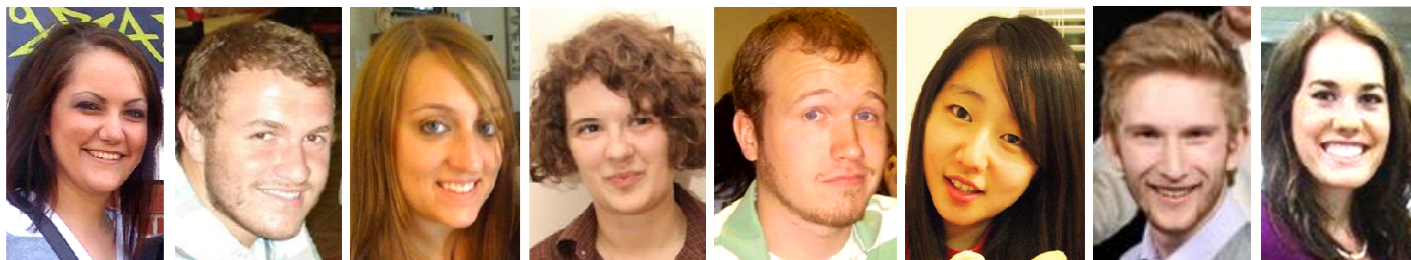
CHRISTMAS WISH LIST
